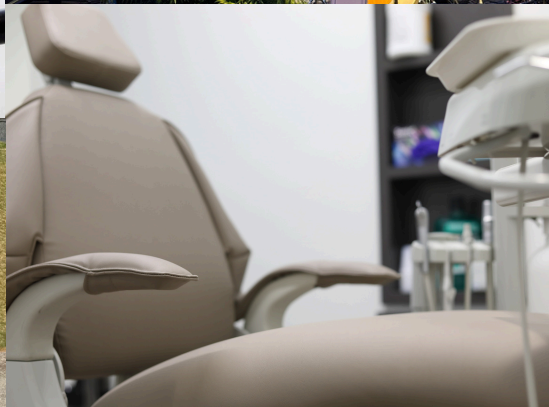
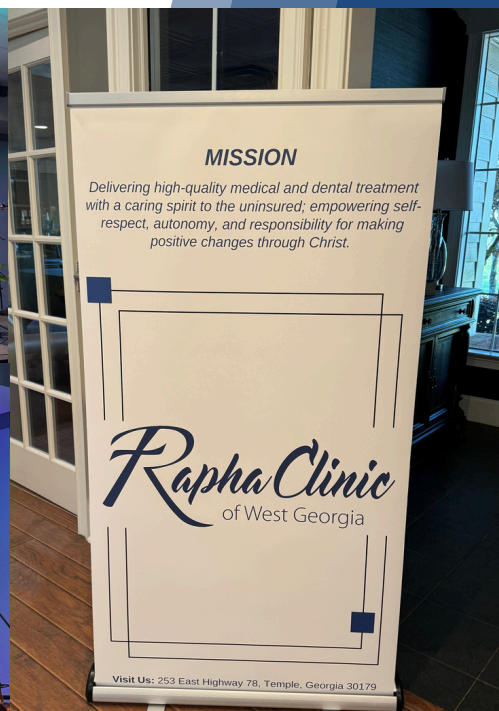

## Story

The Rapha Clinic of West Georgia (Rapha) is a faith-based, non-profit, charitable ministry serving uninsured adults in West Georgia (Carroll, Douglas, Haralson, Heard, and Paulding counties). Volunteer professionals provide high quality medical and dental care to those most in need. In addition to the best healthcare, Rapha patients receive spiritual support and guidance without forcing beliefs. At Rapha, we believe that good health is everyone's responsibility.

## Mission

To deliver high quality medical and dental treatment with a caring spirit to the uninsured; empowering self-respect, autonomy, and responsibility for making positive changes through Christ.

## History

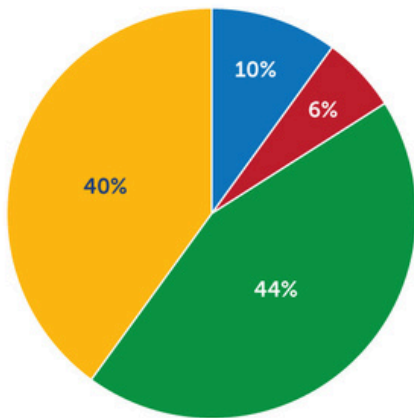
Rapha has been providing free medical care to adults who are at or below 200% of the federal poverty level and uninsured, since opening in 2010. From its beginning in Temple, Rapha began offering basic medical services staffed by volunteer providers. In November 2012, Rapha began providing dental care to West Georgia.

Today, Rapha supports medical and dental care, along with mammograms, healthy lifestyle classes, gynecological exams, and cardio stress testing. Through a Prescription Assistance Program, Rapha helps patients receive some or all of their medications for free. The Tanner Mammography Mobile Unit also partners with Rapha to provide screenings at the clinic.

Rapha believes that chronic health conditions have a direct correlation to spiritual health. It is through caring for the physical illness that Rapha has an opportunity to be a witness for Christ.

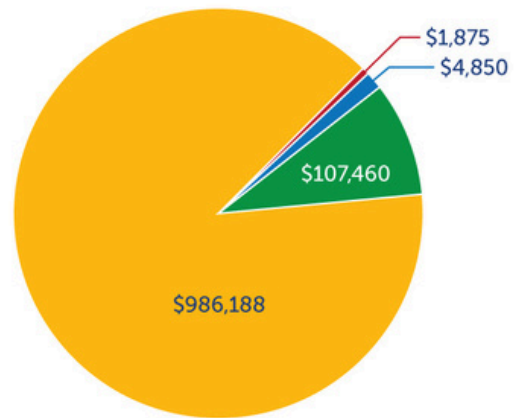

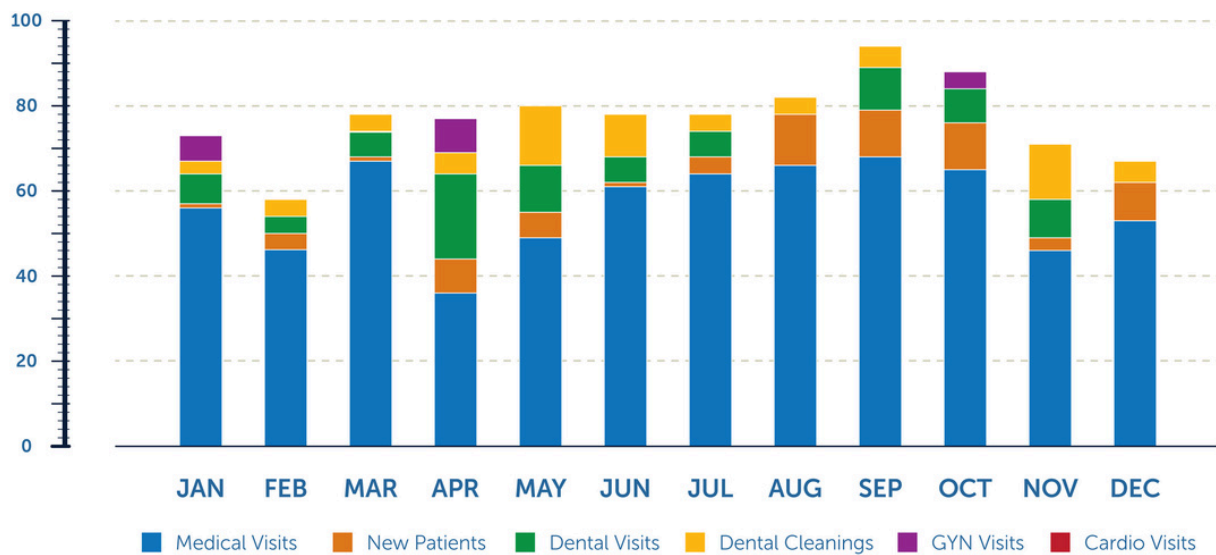

Dear West Georgians,

I write this letter as part of the annual report for the Rapha Clinic of West Georgia, a faith-based medical and dental clinic for the uninsured in West Georgia. I have had the privilege and honor of working with the clinic as a board member for nearly 15 years, and I have been the Medical Director for 11 years. I have practiced medicine for over 20 years, and the disparities in medical care access and quality based on socio-economic factors has always weighed heavy on my heart. The work that we do at the Rapha Clinic lets us address those issues on a local level. Through our devoted nurse practitioner, community volunteers, and our regular staff, we address patient suffering on multiple levels – medical, psychological, and spiritual. We are continually working to improve the physical health, health literacy, and overall wellness of our patients. We also support them spiritually without pressure to accept any faith or religion, and we have guided many patients to a relationship with Jesus Christ. We also help patients obtain needed medications through pharmaceutical company patient assistance programs and other programs open to non-profit medical and dental clinics. We see the impact in the overall improvement in control of their chronic diseases, and we also see it in decreased patient emergency room visits.

Through a variety of fundraisers each year, we increase awareness of the services we offer while also raising needed funds for operational costs through the clinic. This year was the 10th Annual Sound of Medicine fundraiser, marking a decade that we have been bringing together numerous medical providers in the community to showcase their musical talents for our community with an evening of music, fellowship, silent auction, and testimonies from patients about how our work affects their lives.

I am proud as a physician and a Christian to work with such a successful and meaningful healthcare organization. By serving as the hands and feet of Christ in our community, we bless our community and are equally blessed ourselves in return. I look forward to the growth and expansion of our services in the coming years.

I have had the privilege and honor of supporting the clinic as a Board Member for 10 years, overseeing the marketing team and now serving as a co-chair with Dr. Amy Eubanks.

The Rapha Clinic, its volunteers, staff, and clinicians are doing incredible work for patients whose income may impact their ability to receive medical and dental care. Our faith-based mission provides spiritual support to our patients along with our services that include exams, testing, and classes with a caring spirit that empowers them. There is no pressure, but only support, as we guide our patients to receive care.

This past year has been incredibly exciting, as we have added two new fully engaged, inspiring board members: Martha Haack and Julie Strickland. We have increased patient numbers and we have held multiple fundraisers that will return in 2025-2026. Events include:

- The 11th Annual The Sound of Medicine
- A 5K walk/run in partnership with University of West Georgia's Emerging Healthcare Leaders
- The 6th Annual 'Fore Your Health' Golf Tournament

We have received countless grants from institutions such as the Community Foundation of West Georgia, Georgia Charitable Care Network, and Southwire. We are so thankful for these donations to our organization.

With these and other contributions, the medical and dental team continue supporting the needs of nearly 2,000 patients, while we are also installing equipment that enables the clinic to conduct cardiac stress testing for West Georgia individuals. Through the support of a generous local donor, the Rapha Clinic has been able to purchase a treadmill for cardiac stress testing for patients with medical conditions that put them at high risk for cardiovascular disease or who have specific symptoms concerning cardiovascular disease.

I remain honored and humbled to serve as co-chair for the Rapha Clinic Board and am looking forward to the increased care the Rapha team is able to provide in the year ahead. We are forever grateful for the donations and in-kind contributions of our West Georgia community. We pray for your continued support in the coming year.
